

ANNOUNCEMENT: NORTH AFRICA

Following recent negotiations with the German Ministry of Finance, persons who were incarcerated in specific forced labor camps in Tunisia, Algeria and Morocco for six months may be eligible for a pension from the Article 2 Fund, assuming all the other eligibility requirements of the Article 2 Fund have been fulfilled.
