Dear Sir,

Re: A. Accepting the representative of " YESH " [ child survivors, Israel ] to the CC.

B. CC's spending - survivors' sole prerogative

A. It has been for too long the sad and unjust fact that the child survivors of Israel, who are the majority of the survivors in Israel, are not represented on the board of the CC.

Therefore it is our cordial and firm request from you to make right the unjust and unfair situation by making the necessary arrangements so that our representative is included as a full member of the board of the CC in the very near future.

Over 50 years neither our voice nor our rightful claims were heard or met by you or by anyone. Therefore it is the last moment and opportunity for you to correct some of the grave mistakes and injustices. History, together with 200000 child survivors in Israel, have been waiting silently and patiently for too long. Not any more.

B. The child survivors of Israel, together with the great majority of holocaust survivors in Israel and around the world, consider your arrangement of spending 20% of the CC's funds on matters not directly connected with the welfare of survivors- as totally wrong. The funds and assets of the CC belong to the survivors alone. The survivors alone have the right to decide how these funds are to be spent.
